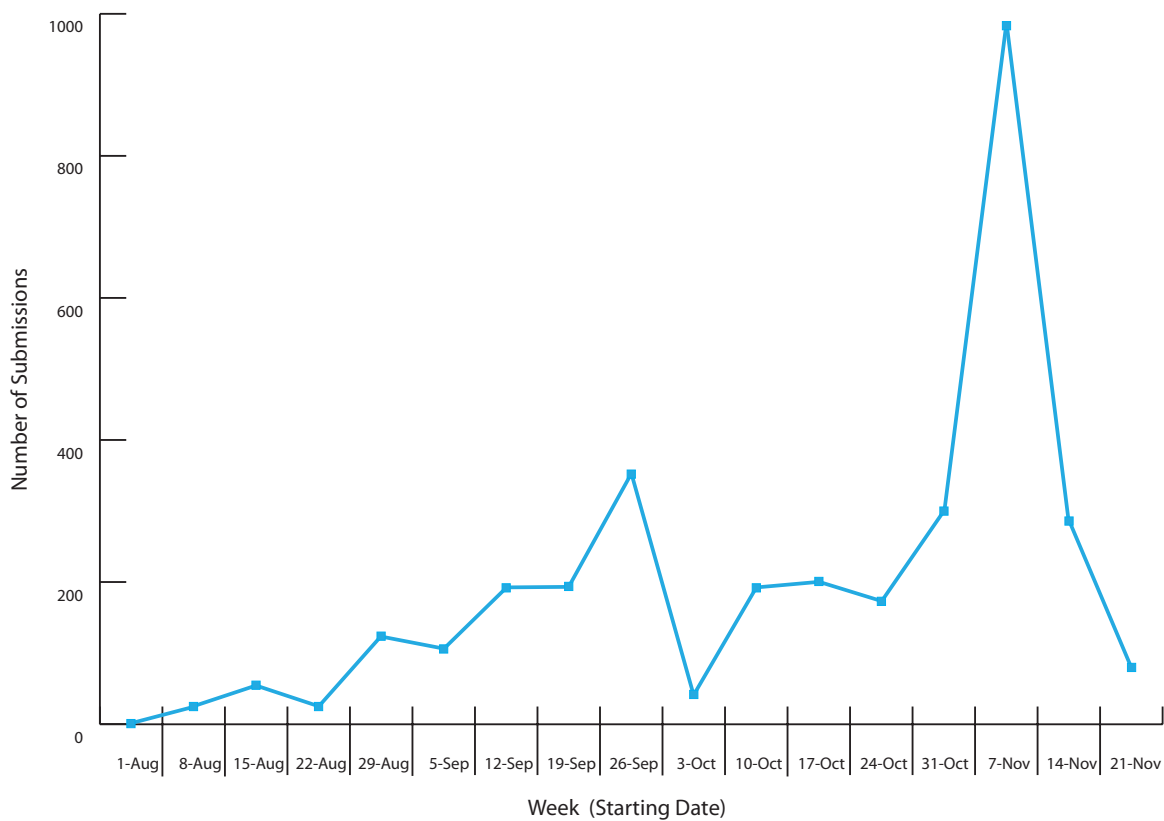
workshops on effective course design, assessment methods and learning management systems and is presently working with EnhanceEdu, IIIT-Hyderabad.
