IIIT-H Wins Third Place at Global Aerospace Contest CanSat 2011

We are delighted to inform you that IIIT-H's team *Mission Gaganyaan* won the **Third Place** at the Finals of *CanSat 2011*, an international aerospace competition held at Abilene, Texas, USA, on June 12, 2011.

Just to remind you, *Mission Gaganyaan* won the **World First Place** last year. Like the past two years, *Mission Gaganyaan* was the *only* team from India to qualify for the World Finals this year.

The CanSat 2011, organized by the American Astronautical Society and sponsored by NASA, required teams to design, fabricate, and launch into the lower space an autonomous micro-satellite carrying a large raw egg of a hen intact, for the entire duration of the flight – from launch to landing.
